5. Each week get the chart stamped and receive a special prize chosen for that week! Each week from July 2nd through August 1st there will be a different prize!

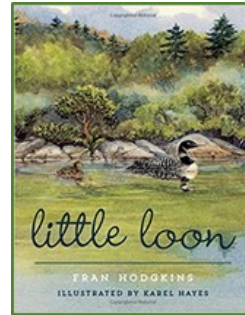
